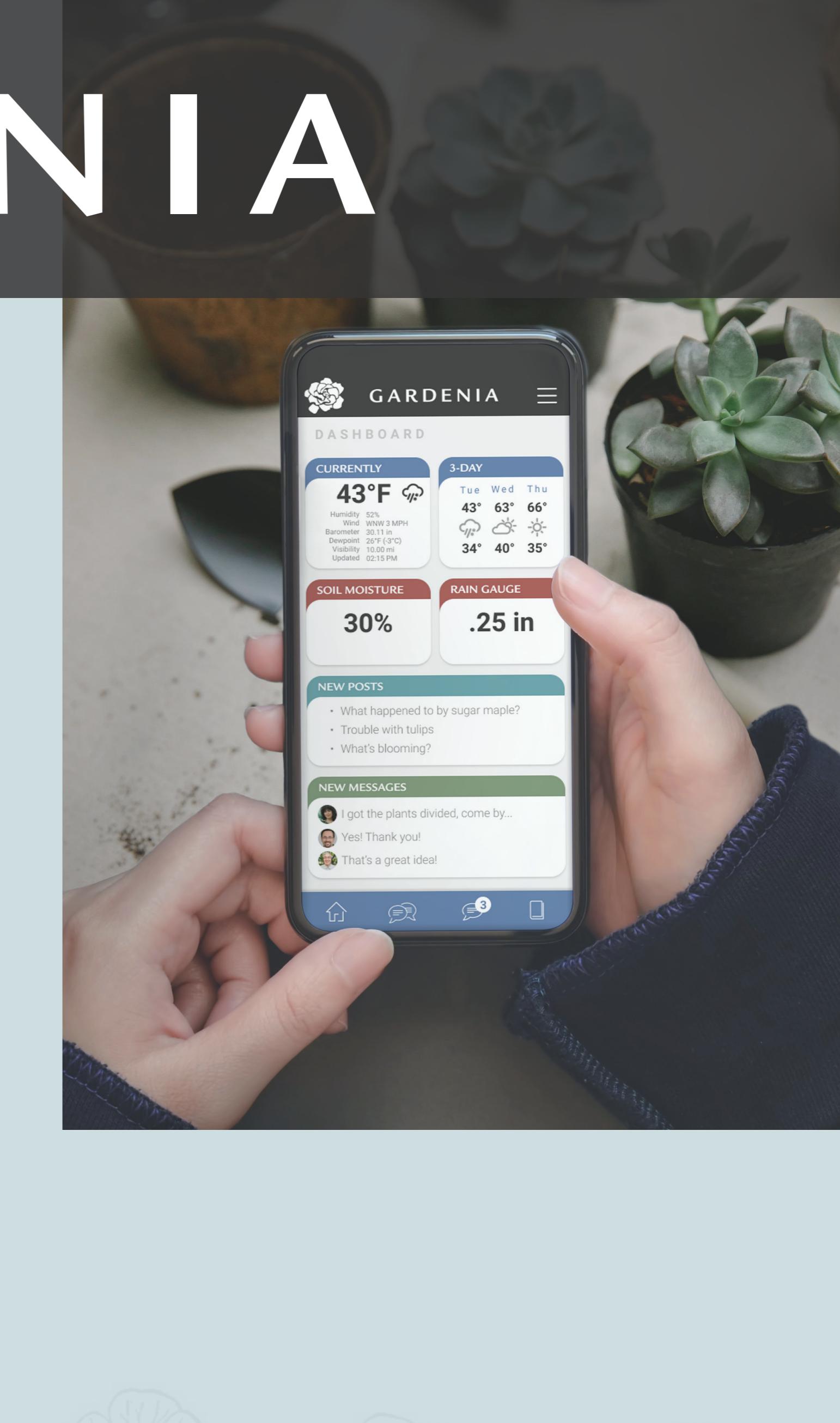


GARDENIA

It is very important to understand your local conditions in order to succeed. While gardening information is abundant on the internet, it is often difficult to find what you need to know for your specific area.



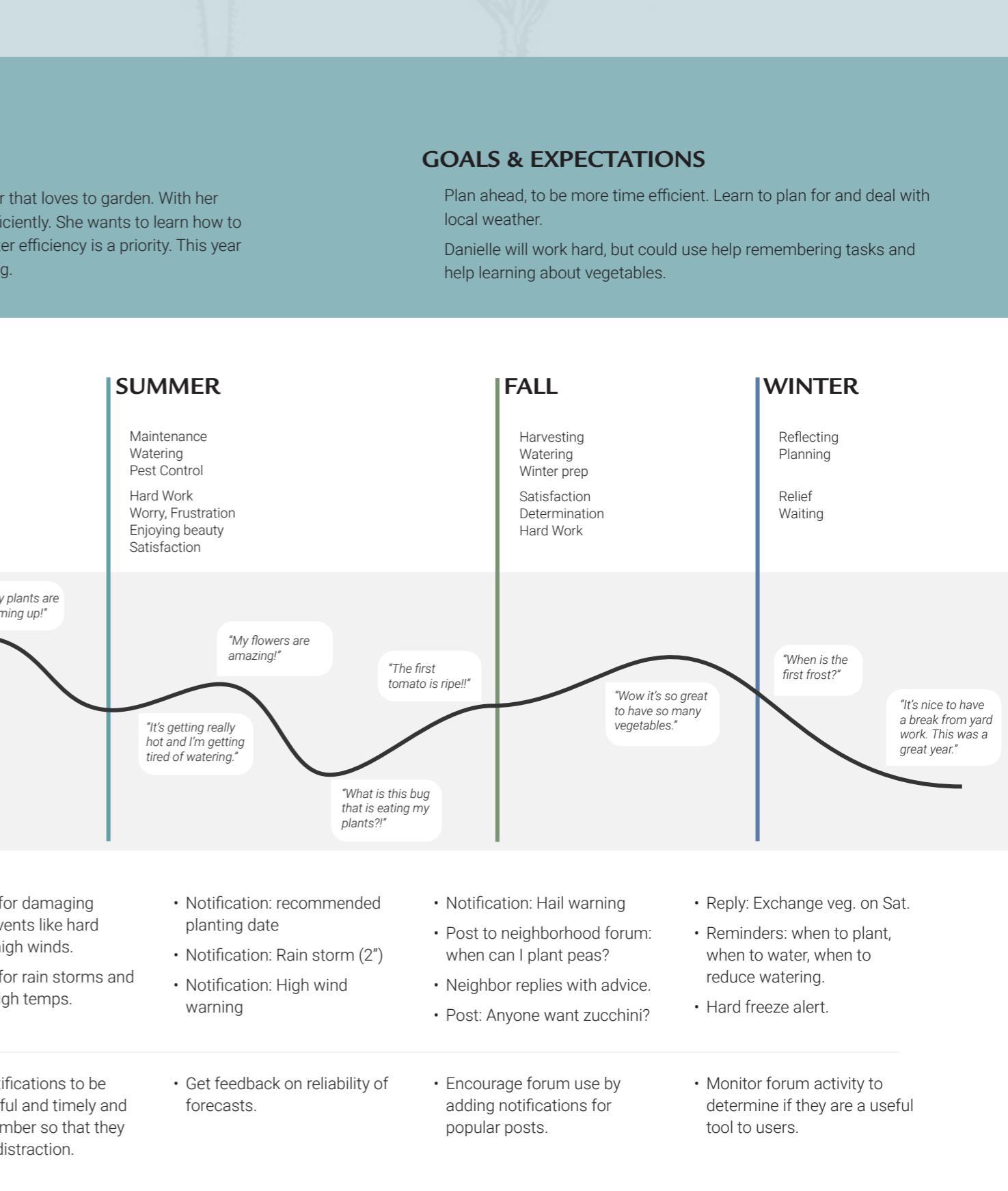
RESEARCH

Gardeners of varied ages and skill levels were interviewed to get a better understanding of what would best support their gardening efforts.

Many of the participants expressed a love for growing things and a belief that they benefit physically and emotionally from gardening.

Another common thread was a frequent need to find helpful information that would be relevant in their specific location.

Gardening efforts are governed by changing weather conditions. Accurate, local information alleviates much of the worry and guesswork.

The Journey Map illustrates the user's path from initial interest to active participation in the Gardenia community. It shows the progression from a simple desire to learn about gardening to a full-fledged passion for local, sustainable agriculture. The map highlights key milestones such as setting goals, learning about local weather patterns, and finally, sharing successes and challenges with a supportive online community.

PLANNING

The wireframes provide a detailed look at the user interface for the Gardenia app. The dashboard features a weather forecast, soil moisture levels, and a rain gauge. It also includes a news feed and a messaging system. The app is designed to be user-friendly, with clear navigation and a clean, modern aesthetic.

WIREFRAMES

The wireframes show the user flow for the Gardenia app. The user starts at the login screen, then moves to the home screen which displays weather, forums, and guides. From the home screen, the user can access various features such as weather, forums, messages, guides, and settings. The weather screen shows a 3-day forecast and soil moisture levels. The forums screen allows users to filter posts by category and read them. The guides screen provides local guides for lawn and garden, trees and shrubs, vegetables, fruits, and herbs, as well as healthy soil and monthly checklists.

SOLUTION

Gardenia is an app that enables gardeners to improve their gardening experience through the use of data and networking. Data from local weather stations as well as personal weather sensors are combined in one app. Local gardening information is collected and local gardeners are connected in one app.

Gardenia helps users find success in gardening by removing the frustrations of guessing how the weather is affecting their garden and by creating connections with local gardeners for help and support.
